

## DAILY BIBLE VERSES AND PRAYER THOUGHTS

**MONDAY** - VERSES: 2 Corinthians 8:1-2 / Mississippi is the poorest state in the U.S., but they are at the top in charitable giving each year ahead of much wealthier states. PRAYER THOUGHT: Ask for help not to make excuses to not give, but to become a better steward.

**TUESDAY** - VERSES: 2 Corinthians 8:3-4 PRAYER

THOUGHT: Help me to give as much as I have the power to give. Help me not to judge others if they are giving more or less than me.

**WEDNESDAY** - VERSES: 2 Corinthians 8:5; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 7:23 PRAYER THOUGHT: Help me to remember that nothing I have is mine, but that I have been blessed with it and am responsible for its use.

**THURSDAY** - VERSES: 2 Corinthians 8:6-7 / Are you giving the same, less, or more than last year, or 5 years ago. PRAYER THOUGHT: Help me to grow in the grace of giving and reach my full potential just as I am growing in other areas of my Christian life.

**FRIDAY** - VERSES: 2 Corinthians 8:8-9 PRAYER THOUGHT: Help me to sincerely desire to give, not to please men, but God. Help me to remember that Christ gave first.

**SATURDAY** - VERSES: 2 Corinthians 8:10-12 PRAYER THOUGHT: Help me to stand by the decisions that I make about how, when, where, and what I will give. Help me to perform as I determined and not to turn back for selfish reasons.

### ASSIGNMENTS

1. At least once a day read over this material and read or sing the song.
2. Place the scripture where you will see it each day.
3. Think of how you can give more for Christ and work on one way all week.
4. Pray for God's help in difficult times to remember that God never asks more than we can give.
5. Write down the blessings that come from being a better giver.

## SPIRITUAL HEALTH REGIMEN - WEEK 52 CHEERFUL GIVING - 7-21-13 to 7-27-13

**SCRIPTURE** - 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

**COMMENT** – God showed the example when He willingly and cheerfully gave us His son. He had purposed it in His heart before the world began and He followed through with the decision He had made. He didn't do it because He had to and no one forced Him to against His will. Jesus was the same in His attitude. He even said no one was taking His life, but He was giving it - John 10:18. God wants us to give, but he wants us to want to give like He has always wanted to give.

Acts 5:1-5 "But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, {2} And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it, at the apostles' feet. {3} But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? {4} Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. {5} And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things."

### III. GIVE A PERFECT GIFT - GOD DID

A. 2 Cor 9:6-7 "But this I say, He which soweth sparingly

shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. {7} Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver."

### IV. GIVE A PRICELESS GIFT - GOD DID

A. Acts 3:6 "Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk."

B. 2 Cor 9:12-13 "For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; {13} Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men;"

### V. GIVE A PERSONAL GIFT - GOD DID

A. Rom 12:1 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."

B. Phil 4:15-18 "Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only. {16} For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity. {17} Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account. {18} But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God."
